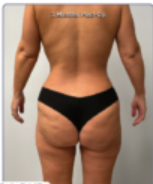
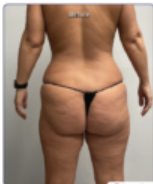


## Flanks and Inner Thighs Case Example #1
